RED SHOT raced up close, chased three-wide into the stretch, rallied and got up late, driving. CHILKOOT PASS settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn and rallied determinedly outside rivals. MR. MONTY set a pressured pace, drew clear upper stretch then gave way in the late stages. DIXIE TROOP showed brief speed, forced the issue then gave way grudgingly in the stretch. KID CANUCK raced in midpack, chased on the turn then finished gamely between horses. CROWNS DYNASTY, off slowly, chased in range, came four-wide into the stretch then flattened out late. OLD BLUE EYES raced in midpack between foes, was hustled five-wide into the stretch then lacked a closing response. KIPS CALERO was hustled early but dropped off the pace, chased on the turn but never reached contention.
