**Footnotes**

RON C stalked the pace, closed on the backstretch and took command at the turn, was hustled clear then held sway under a drive. FUTURE KING, well back early, circled fast on the far turn, launched his drive but lugged in through the stretch and had to be taken in hand late. SEANAIEH raced in midpack, closed along the rail through the far turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. VINTAGE STORM, well back early, chased along the rail through the far turn then evened out in deep stretch. NICKANGE ONE, in midpack early, chased hard on the far turn then tired in the stretch. IMPEL settled far back, was hustled on the final turn but never reached contention. NICOLINO broke outward and settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn but lacked a rally. A BIT OF DAN led quickly, set the pace, was headed at the far turn, chased briefly and tired. TANGO EVENT, off slowly, raced well off the pace, was through by the far turn, faded, finished the race and walked off.
