

TOUCHNOW, off a step slow, raced off the pace, closed three-wide on the far turn, gained steadily in the stretch and got up late. WARM RAIN led on the first turn, set a reserved pace then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. TURTLE DRIVE stumbled at the start, was four-wide on the first turn, stalked the pace, launched a bid outside WARM RAIN early on the far turn but could not get up, chased to the stretch and lacked a strong late response. MY REAL QUIET LADY stalked the pace, was hustled on the far turn then evened out. HALIBURTON HONEY stalked from the rail, chased on the far turn then lacked a stretch response. DIDYCHEATAMANDHOWE stalked the pace between rivals, was close ion the backstretch then faded between horses early on the far turn. TIS UNANSWERABLE, four-wide on the first turn and three-wide on the far turn, was always well off the pace and lacked a rally.
