SUDSY BABY led early, was headed, forced the pace bid late turn, dueled into the stretch and drove clear late. KNIGHTS TEMPLAR stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch then rallied gamely. HOWABOUTRIGHTNOW took the lead midbackstretch, set a pressured pace, was engaged and vied from midturn then weakened in the late stages. DORVAL SPECIAL stalked from the rail, was roused late turn then evened out in the stretch. ANA'S WHIPPER raced from off the pace, closed inside along the rail on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch then hung. FOREST CHAPEL, well back early, closed mildly on the turn and did not threaten. DARK RAINBOW dropped back after a sharp beginning, trailed to the stretch then passed tired foes. ANGEL'S CHORUS raced midpack, was hard ridden on the turn then lacked a stretch response. HIGH WAGE was hustled along three-wide and faded late turn.
