The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight Three-Year-Olds 118 lbs.; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times at a mile or over in 2005-2006 allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 5 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 once at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 7 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$60,000 once at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 9 lbs.; Of a race other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over in 2005-2006, 11 lbs. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500, which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$11,040 Ontario Sired/Ontario Breeder Awards. Closed Wednesday, July 5, 2006 with 14 nominations.

MISS CONCERTO forced the pace in hand, bid into the far turn, vied outside COASTAL FORTRESS and prevailed late under a drive. COASTAL FORTRESS led early, set a reserved pace, vied through the far turn and stretch then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. BALLROOM DEPUTY, rated early inside, remained in touch, was roused at the top of the stretch but could not gain on the leaders. FLAMING HEART raced off the pace, edged closer on the backstretch, was roused repeatedly through the turn but had no response. SILVER IMPULSE, in hand early, trailed the field, was all out in the stretch but showed no gain.
