WELLOILEDMACHINE led into the first turn, set the pace, drew off on the backstretch, quickened late turn and was all out to hold in the stretch. THOR'S PIPER, in range, chased four-wide on the far turn, finished all out and was gaining late. GRAND RAPPORT raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. CROWN'S PATH stumbled at the start, showed brief speed then settled in range, chased on the far turn but evened out in the late stages. PORT STANLEY raced off the pace, saved ground, closed late turn then evened out in deep stretch. COLD HARBOR settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but flattened out in the stretch. GUIPAGO, steadied slightly at the start, raced off the pace, chased four and five-wide on the far turn then lacked a rally. GOOD BETTER BEST stalked the pace, was hustled late turn then tired in the stretch.
