Footnotes

ALAYA stalked the pace from between rivals, closed late turn, bid upper stretch and quickly drove clear. HIGHLAND DEED stalked four-wide, bid late turn, vied briefly, was no match for ALAYA but finished all out. COFFEE TIME raced midpack three-deep, lacked a path late turn and at the top of the stretch then finished gamely when clear. FLASHY PINK raced from off the pace, closed five-wide late turn and rallied mildly outside. FOXS CONSORT, close early, dropped back entering the turn, saved ground then rallied late between horses. IMPRESSARIA dueled early, was headed by DRIVING MS CHELSEA, forced the pace, rebid late turn but gave way in the stretch. SHERRY'S ATTORNEY, squeezed back just out, remained well back to late turn, was roused three-wide then finished gamely to no avail. DRIVING MS CHELSEA dueled from the rail, took a short lead into the turn, was engaged nearing the top of the

stretch then tired after a brief duel. ISLAND ALLURE raced midpack three-deep, was under a ride late turn and was all out in the stretch. GEM FIRE, well back early, raced three-deep, was bumped hard at the top of the stretch and evened out. ALWAYS HOPE, prominent early, stalked from the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch. J J'S CREEK, close early, stalked the pace from between horses then tired in the stretch. REPEAT EDITION, always well off the pace, was never a factor. POCO BAY dropped back on the turn, raced five-wide, came in at the top of the stretch and bumped GEM FIRE hard and was through.
