(No Canadian Bred Allowance) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$5,000, which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$17,940 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. \$100,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program and Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society. Nominations closed Wednesday, July 12, 2006 with 16.

Footnotes

LIKE A GEM, in touch between horses, closed late turn, bid less than a furlong out and prevailed under a drive. STRIKE SOFTLY raced prominently from the outset, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch, shook clear near the 1/8 pole but gave way grudgingly to LIKE A GEM in the final sixteenth. SPRIGHTLY raced midpack, gained three-wide late turn, came five-wide into the stretch and rallied determinedly. KIMCHI forced the pace, bid late turn, briefly gained a slight lead approaching the top of the stretch, dueled with STRIKE SOFTLY but yielded nearing the 1/8 pole. SCARLET BUTTERFLY, rated early along the rail, gained late turn, was in range at the top of the stretch, but hung. SWEET BREANNA stalked from between foes, was hustled three-wide late turn but was not a threat. PLEASANT AMELIA stalked from the outside, closed up three-wide late turn then flattened out in the stretch. OUR MADISON bobbled at the start, saved ground while racing off the pace but lacked a rally. EENY MEENY trailed the field, raced three-wide on the turn and never reached contention. ELECTRIC SKY raced midpack between foes, finished evenly. LA GRAN MARYLIN raced off the pace two wide, came five-wide into the stretch then lacked a rally. CLEOPATRA'S NEEDLE raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn then had no stretch response.
