GOT YOU COVERED showed early speed alongside rivals, chased four and five-wide on the turn, launched a confident stretch drive and was up in the late stages under a strong hand ride. ROYAL FIGHTER, steadied slightly at the start, showed speed, gained a short lead into the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but yielded in the final 16th. HANDSUP MONEYDOWN had early speed, chased six-wide into the turn, was hustled along then finished evenly. EVER RINGING ducked in at the start, showed speed, forced the pace on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. FERRY INN pressed the pace, backed away at the turn, was hustled into the stretch but was not a threat. LEADING TO WIN, off a step slowly, was hustled from off the pace, came four-wide through the turn but did not threaten. MORELON pressed the pacesetter from the inside, checked at the turn, chased to the stretch but lacked a rally. GOLD FIX, in range early backstretch, settled off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then lacked a rally.
