Footnotes

ONE BIG GATOR stalked the pace, closed late on the far turn, bid a furlong out, drew clear quickly and finished under a hand ride. SPORTS SELECT set a reserved pace, quickened into the stretch, was caught and headed a furlong out and had enough left to hold the place. EDDINGTON LIMIT raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn and rallied gamely. PIT ALLEY raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. LANGFUHR COUNTRY settled off the pace, chased from the rail late turn then evened out in the stretch. WAR RIDGE raced off the pace, came three-wide through the far turn, was roused approaching the stretch but flattened out. RAGING STAR stalked the pace, chased on the far turn then tired in the stretch.
