**Footnotes**

ROSHARON, under strong restraint late backstretch and early turn, closed three-wide, bid upper stretch and drew clear then held under a drive. SUNDAY SENSATION bobbled at the start, remained unhurried to late turn, closed along the inside, angled out at the top of the stretch then finished determinedly. TEMPERANCE LAKE, well back between horses, closed three-deep leaving the turn and continued gamely in the stretch. MISS FILIBUSTER stalked from the third path then hung in the stretch. CHARMING PROPOSAL dueled on the backstretch, drew clear approaching the turn, set the pace but yielded upper stretch. THETACTICS OFDANCE raced midpack, came two deep through the turn then lacked a closing response. DANISH FAIRYTALE (DEN), well back early between foes, lacked a rally. CYPRIATA stalked from the second path then tired in the stretch. ARIEL'S MELODY had speed between horses but moved to the rail, was engaged by CHARMING PROPOSAL, dueled with that one, yielded nearing the turn, chased briefly then faded. CRUISING EXECUTIVE stalked four-wide through the turn, tired in the stretch.
