CLUBAY stalked the pace, closed three-wide and bid late turn, drew clear upper stretch then held NUMEROUSASTHESTARS and MISS CONCERTO safe under good handling. NUMEROUSASTHESTARS, always in touch, was under a ride four-wide late turn, launched an all-out rally outside rivals but failed to get up. MISS CONCERTO, taken back early, was set down three-wide midturn and finished all out between foes. CHARM'S LUCKY LADY stalked the pace, was well positioned upper stretch but hung. HONEY GREEN dropped back along the rail early turn, swung wide at the top of the stretch and rallied late. RAINBOW WOMAN led early, set a reserved pace, was engaged late turn, yielded at the top of the stretch and tired.
