CROSS EVERY BRIDGE led early, was under pressure on the backstretch, quickened into the turn and moved clear then held sway under light handling. SMOKEY FIRE, in touch, closed five-wide leaving the turn and finished determinedly. CRYPTONITE KID, in touch, closed upper stretch, failed to get up and chased the winner home. GONE TRAJECTORY raced off the pace, chased into the stretch and rallied gamely. SWINTON stalked three-wide, angled out upper stretch then lacked a strong closing response. CAPTAIN RAUCOUS raced off the pace, was hustled late turn, was roused five-wide at the top of the stretch but failed to menace. MUSEEB forced the pace from midway of the backstretch, was cleared and stalked on the turn, was all out in the stretch then tired. SEVERI raced off the pace, chased four-wide into the stretch and flattened out.
