Footnotes

BOBCAYGEON, bothered at the start, raced off the pace, closed late backstretch and turn, came five-wide into the stretch, rallied and got up late, driving. OPENING MEET, in range, closed inside rivals on the far turn, bid along the rail near the 1/4 pole, shook clear at the top of the stretch, finished all out but was caught at the wire. CARDIAC REHAB raced off the pace, closed on the backstretch, bid five-wide late turn, was headed and gave chase then flattened out midstretch. LAMAZING stalked the pace, was hustled late turn, bid near the 1/4 pole, dueled to the stretch then tired a furlong out. SHARONS PRINCE, rated off the pace, closed on the backstretch, was hustled through the far turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch but failed to tender a bid. QUIET ON SET ducked out at the start, raced in range, closed on the backstretch, challenged midturn, dueled but tired at the top of the stretch. RODEO BOY led early, set a reserved pace, was swarmed midway through the far turn, dueled briefly and tired at the top of the stretch. BENEVOLENT KNIGHT stalked the pace while pulling early, settled late backstretch, was hustled on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. BEST BEWARE, off slowly, was always far back and lacked a rally. ONE THOUSAND PLUS raced midpack, dropped back on the backstretch and lacked a closing response.
