Footnotes

ATLANTIC HURRICANE stalked the pace from the second path, bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear then held sway under a hand ride. FANTASTIC COUSIN raced in midpack, closed three and four-wide on the turn, launched her bid at the top of the stretch and finished all out. MISS CLAIRTON (GB) stalked the pace, closed late turn, bid three-wide at the top of the stretch, was outkicked, chased briefly and evened out. TWIST OF SILVER raced off the pace, was hustled angling three to five-wide on the turn but evened out in the stretch. MISS LOLA, well back early, saved ground, angled out through the stretch but never reached contention. MISS TAGGART raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn but lacked a closing response. STREET PRIZE led early, set a pressured pace in hand, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired.
