Footnotes

PLAYING FOOTSIE squeezed back and steadied slightly on the first turn, stalked the duel, bid into the far turn and moved clear easily, widened leaving the turn then held FAR AND NEAR safe under a drive. FAR AND NEAR in range throughout, closed hard after the leader on the far turn then finished gamely and was clearly best of the rest. CLASSY SOLUTION raced four-wide midpack, closed late on the far turn then hung in the stretch. WINDINTHEVALLEY broke in the air, closed along the rail on the backstretch, moved off the rail to get around a rival late turn then flattened out in the stretch. LETSMOVEON stumbled at the start, closed along the second path on the backstretch and through the turn then hung in the stretch. SKIP'N FOOL trailed early, gained four-wide on the far turn then flattened out. PINK JADE raced midpack, came four-wide and gained marginally late turn then flattened out. TEMPT HER dueled from the rail, was no match for the winner on the far turn but gave chase then tired in the stretch. JULES RULES stalked the pace to the far turn then faded three-wide. CAT IN DEED dueled to the far turn and tired. A stewards' inquiry into the start of the race did not alter the results.
