DEVIL'S BLAST pressed the pacesetter from between rivals but was squeezed back at the turn, moved to the rail and closed late turn, took command a furlong out and drove clear. BEDTIME STORY raced off the pace, closed between foes late turn, rallied gamely and gained steadily through the stretch. MY ANNA, in range four-wide, bid late turn, gained the lead upper stretch, was headed a furlong out and gave way grudgingly. CATERINAMARIA raced

midpack from the outside, chased six-wide late turn and finished gamely. SHESTWEAKIN settled midpack, raced four to six-wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. WALKERS BEACH, in midpack early, chased six-wide late turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. LOOKING FOR ACTION settled off the pace, angled out late turn, was hustled into the stretch but failed to threaten. HIGHLAND FLARE raced off the pace, was hustled seven-wide into the stretch but also did not menace. PIVOTAL DECISION raced off the pace from between rivals, was hustled late turn but lacked a stretch response. SECRET TRAIL led quickly, set a pressured pace, vied from late turn and tired at the top of the stretch. WEST COAST MISS, in range along the rail, moved up inside the leader entering the turn but failed to match strides, chased to the stretch and tired. WINDANCER'S CHARM raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch and tired.
