JIMMY SIMMS led early, set a relaxed pace, quickened upper stretch then held sway under a drive. FIFTEEN LOVE stalked two and three-wide, launched a strong stretch drive, was gaining late and finished best of the rest. TORQUAY stalked the pace along the rail, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the final 16th. WOLLEMI PINE stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn, was hustled in the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. GET RICH QUICK was unhurried early, angled five-wide late turn but lacked a strong closing response. ROYAL OATH raced midpack three and four-wide and never reached contention. AWESOME ACTION raced off the pace, angled out late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then lacked a rally.
