### Footnotes

DREAMY MOONLITE stalked the pace, bid three-wide into the turn, dueled, gained a short led briefly upper stretch, was headed by MISER in the final furlong but battled back courageously and regained the lead in deep stretch. MISER, rated in range, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch, took a short lead in the final furlong but failed to hold near the wire. HIGHLANDDIXIEBELLE raced midpack, chased late turn, came eight-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied. MY DESTINY raced off the pace, was hustled five to nine-wide on the turn then finished gamely to no avail. BEST OF ALY forced the pace from the inside, dueled late backstretch and turn but yielded upper stretch. BLONDEONTHEBEACH dueled to upper stretch and gave way. GRACE BY MOONLIGHT raced off the pace, trailed late turn, chased three-wide into the stretch and rallied mildly. FLASHY EPISODE, away alertly, showed brief speed, settled midpack, came four and five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out. THATSWHATYOUTHINK raced in midpack, came five to seven-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. BAR IS OPEN stalked the pace, was contentious four and five-wide on the turn but tired upper stretch.
