MO JO QUEEN led briefly then stalked the pacesetter, closed gradually four-wide turn, bid upper stretch drove clear with confidence and finished under a hand ride. TAPIA settled off the pace, responded upper stretch then rallied willingly between foes. GENES NORTHERNSTAR was away alertly then settled in midpack, came four and five-wide through the turn then launched an all out drive outside the field. STREET PRIZE settled off the the pace, closed

four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out late. MAYS TREASURETROVE, in range, closed along the rail late turn, bid upper stretch but was outkicked and evened out. FULL STEAM AHEAD raced in midpack, chased hard between foes late turn but never reached contention. YANKEE CANDY raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the turn, finished gamely but did not menace. QUIT WORRYING moved to the early lead, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn but was headed upper stretch and tired. MAELLE, in range, saved ground, but flattened out in the final furlong. BONITA BELLA settled off the pace, was roused two-wide late turn but had no response. SPEND TO SAVE forced the pace, backed away early turn and tired. FAVORITE MELODY dropped to the rear, trailed and lacked a rally.
