Footnotes

TACTICAL STAR was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused in the turn and started a rally, came outside of PROMISING WEST entering the stretch, assumed command with less than a furlong to go then drew clear under steady pressure. PROMISING WEST showed speed in the backstretch and sprinted to an unchallenged lead, held a clear advantage to deep stretch, but tired in the final furlong and gave way in the final strides. PERPETUAL BLAZE was void of early speed, roused just off the rail in the turn and made a mild rally three wide in the drive. NIGHT IN SEATTLE was allowed to settle three wide and lacked a late response. SHASTA DAISY was allowed to settle and saved ground through the turn, never rallied and was never a threat. RUBY CANYON was off slowly and showed no speed. DEED TO ROYALTY was unhurried early and never a factor.
