BEAR CHOCOLATED forced the pace from the rail, gained a short led into the turn, was joined in a duel, moved clear approaching the stretch then held under a drive. ROCKIN HEAT, in range, closed three-wide to five-wide on the turn, rallied determinedly outside and just missed. KISSED BY A GHOST, in range two-wide, chased into the stretch then finished evenly. BLUEDEVILSPRAYER broke in the air and bumped with a rival, moved up quickly to press the pace, chased hard late turn then evened out in the stretch. BREAKING BALL stalked along the rail, was roused late turn, chased into the stretch and tired. COBALT CAT, bumped at the start, settled off the pace, was hustled late turn then evened out in the stretch. COALBROOK led quickly, was headed late backstretch, rebid early turn, dueled, was headed late turn and tired. WHY DAT, off slowly, was hustled along the rail on the turn then lacked a closing response. RIFLE raced off the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn, was hustled along then tired in the stretch. LEMON PEEL raced midpack, was steadied behind traffic at the turn, was hustled two and three-wide but showed no stretch response.
