BUSH DOCTOR, away alertly, stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn, bid in the final furlong dueled and prevailed under a drive. B VEXED, in range, was hustled along the rail on the turn, bid inside the leader in the final furlong, dueled but was outfinished. ILL BE HONEST, away slowly, settled off the pace, chased angled from two to five-wide through the turn then rallied late outside the field. LORD OF ESSA stalked the pace, was roused four-wide late turn and finished gamely. MIDNIGHT BLACK, rated off the pace, closed five-wide on the turn and finished under a determined drive. ENGLISH LORD, prominent early, was headed entering the main track, stalked the pace, chased two and three-wide on the far turn but flattened out in the stretch. SCRAM ITS THE HAWK forced the pace briefly and settled in midpack, chased two-wide on the turn then finished gamely along the rail in the stretch. BIG SHOOTER bobbed at the start, moved up quickly and forced the pace, took command entering the main track, set the pace then gave way in the stretch.
