Footnotes

SOUNDTRACK was slow early and settled along the rail, roused on the turn while saving ground, slipped through in mid stretch and was full of run getting up in the final strides. MARJORIE DAW was allowed to settle in the three path, roused in upper stretch and closed willingly between horses getting up for place. SKIPPING STONE was in hand inside of rivals, split horses in upper stretch and finished well. FANTASTIC ALLIE bore out at the start and bumped with VACUNA, recovered quickly and stalked the early pace, drew even in upper stretch, but failed to sustain the bid and weakened. VACUNA was allowed to settle just off the rail, roused four wide on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. MIDWAY WEST was unhurried early between horses and lacked a late response. QUEEN OF THE SEA was allowed to settle inside of rivals, closed the gap in upper stretch, but failed to respond and was never a threat. MATILDA DANCER was slow early, swung wide at the three eighths pole and rallied belatedly. PHONE DANCER was unhurried early between horses, roused in upper stretch and finished with a mild bid. FLEET DEED was allowed to settle in the three path and never rallied. STORMY SOCIETY was allowed to settle four wide, then dropped back on the turn. BONITA BAY showed speed in the backstretch and opened a clear lead, but faltered in upper stretch and faded to last.
