Footnotes

REGAL PUSHER bid early on the backstretch, took command nearing the turn, set the pace and held sway under a strong hand ride. RAYKHA raced off the pace, closed late turn then rallied fast between horses. DANCING LEAVES stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn, launched a bid upper stretch, failed to get up and hung. GENIVER raced midpack between foes, was hustled on the turn, angled out and finished all out. IRISH CATON showed early

speed, chased along the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch. WHISKY SWISH, well back two-wide, rallied late inside. FRIENDLY PASSAGE stalked from between foes, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. CLEVER DARLEY raced midpack between horses, lacked a stretch response. ELEFHERIA raced off the pace along the rail, never reached contention. SOLD THE GOLD, well back early, was roused four-wide late turn but showed no response. SPRINGLEGE broke alertly, was joined in a duel, was headed late backstretch, gave chase then tired. ARCHERESS dropped back late backstretch, faded three-wide and trailed home.
