HEY BATTER BATTER, in touch, chased late turn, bid a furlong out and drove clear. CONGOR BAY raced in midpack, chased hard four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. JET SET EXEC settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn, chased in the stretch but was outfinished for place. DANIEL BE GOOD dueled, held a short lead on the turn, was headed a furlong out and gave way. SAND BANDIT settled well back, was hustled on the turn but was force to move out a bit to get past a fading rival approaching the turn then did not threaten. EUROVALENTINO dueled, forced the pace on the turn then gave way nearing the top of the stretch. TUMERIC raced in midpack, chased two and three-wide on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. MAKAAAN showed brief speed then settled and stalked the pace then faded while drifting out late turn.
