**Footnotes**

FORESTER'S DIVA, always in range, came four and five-wide through the turn, rallied, took command in the final furlong, was drawing off when her rider discarded his whip approaching the 70 yard pole and finished under a strong hand ride. MISS SCARLETT ROAD pressed the pace, took the lead early turn, edged clear, was passed in the final furlong but was game and held place. PRINCESS PICK, in range, chased hard late turn and finished gamely. WHITE ROAD pressed the pace, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. SWINGWITHTHERING pressed the pace to the turn, dropped back but was still determined in the stretch. FLASHY EPISODE led early, was headed at the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. SOAP OPERA STAR, off slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention.
