**Footnotes**

SAFETY ZONE stalked the pace, dueled on the far turn, led into the stretch, was soon joined, dueled, then drove clear in the late stages. JABALI stalked the pace, bid upper stretch, dueled, then gave way grudgingly in the final 16th. FLIP FOR THE COIN, away slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide on the turn then finished under a determined drive. WAR RIDGE settled off the pace, closed three to six-wide on the far turn but evened out in deep stretch. FAYE'S GRAY settled in midpack, was hustled three and four-wide on the far turn then evened out in the final 16th. ONE BIG GATOR raced in midpack, was roused four-wide late turn but never reached contention. RUNAWAY CONTENDER set a pressured pace, backed away on the far turn and lacked a rally. CONTROL raced in midpack, dropped back on the far turn and likewise lacked a rally. EAST POINT forced the pace, bid into the far turn, dueled, chased into the stretch and tired.
