ALPHA BETTOR showed brief speed then stalked the pacesetter two-wide, cut to the rail upper stretch, bid midstretch and prevailed, driving. ULTIMATE DESTINY left with the others despite his gate opening prematurely, showed speed, shook clear on the clubhouse turn, set a pressured pace, was challenged midstretch and although game, was outfinished. AWESOME OVERTURE had brief speed, pressed the pace on the backstretch, was hustled close up on the turn, failed with a bid late turn, forced the issue in the stretch but hung. PEYTON, off slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled late turn, chased five-wide into the stretch and rallied late outside. PERFECT AFLEET raced in midpack, chased five-wide into the stretch then finished gamely in vain. ANY GIVEN ROYAL settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn then finished gamely along the rail. JAMES STREET, close early, stalked the pace, chased late turn but evened out in deep stretch. PATRIOTICANDPROUD settled off the early pace, was hustled from midpack on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. AFTER A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START OF THE RACE, ULTIMATE DESTINY WAS DECLARED A NON-STARTER AND DISQUALIFIED BECAUSE HIS GATE OPENED PREMATURELY GIVING HIM AN UNFAIR ADVANTAGE. AFTER REVIEW, THE RULING WAS OVERTURNED.
