Footnotes

ASCOT ANNIE raced midpack two-wide, closed late turn, angled out upper stretch, rallied gamely and swept by a furlong out. NIGHT FEVER, well back early, closed into the stretch and gained steadily. MIDNIGHT JOKER had brief speed then settled and stalked the pace, bid at the top of the stretch, gained a short lead but failed to hold in the final furlong. DO IT ANYWAY raced midpack four-wide, angled out in the stretch then rallied late outside. SPECIAL MOMENT, in range, chased four-wide into the turn, was still contentious six-wide at the top of the stretch, was all out but hung late. SHORT SHORTS raced midpack three-wide, closed into the stretch, tendered a mild rally midstretch then then evened out. WICKED EMER stalked three-wide between horses, was in contention behind traffic in the stretch then flattened out out. SPANISH DEPUTY dueled between horses, gave way midstretch and tired. HIGHLAND FLARE raced midpack two-wide, was all out in the stretch but evened out in the final furlong. SANTINA D'OR stalked two-wide, chased into the stretch then tired a sixteenth out. LA MANCHA raced midpack along the rail, was hustled into the stretch, angled out but lacked a rally. PURPLE MOON showed brief speed then settled, stalked the duel four-wide, closed up at the top of the stretch, chased briefly then tired. DESIRE AND FIRE raced off the pace, came

three-wide through the turn and never reached contention. BOLD MANEUVER dueled along the rail then tired upper stretch.
