### Footnotes

STEADY STUART, in range, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch, rallied willingly and was up late under a hand ride. DUCK TRAIL took the early lead, set pace, had command to deep stretch, was headed and gave way grudgingly. SHADES OF GOLD, in range between rivals, was hustled five-wide late turn then finished under a determined drive. OBJECTION DENIED, in range along the rail, chased into the stretch then evened out late. HAVING SAID THAT raced off the pace along the second path, was hustled hard late turn but never reached contention. BUBBI'S BAY raced off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide late turn, chased into the stretch but never threatened. UNION EXECUTIVE raced well back, angled from the rail to four-wide on the turn, finished gamely but did not menace. AEOLUS raced midpack, angled from three to five-wide on the turn and was never in contention. REGAL RING stalked two and three-wide, chased late turn then flattened out in the stretch. CLASSIC EXECUTIVE settled well off the pace and lacked strong closing response. STRONG POSIBILITIS, off a step slowly, dropped back to last early, trailed through the turn and lacked a rally.
