DUBAI CALLING stalked the pace in hand, chased four-wide into the stretch, launched a determined drive and got up late. TAPIA raced midpack early between rivals, stalked on the turn, chased from the top of the stretch but quickly encountered traffic, altered course, lost her path and was steadied midstretch then rallied late to garner second. SWEET STARLET, rated midpack, chased into the stretch, angled out and rallied gamely. GENTLE ANGEL set a reserved pace, was collared upper stretch, dueled, but was headed by others in the late stages. QUEEN ON LINE pressed the pace, stalked on the turn, bid upper stretch, dueled but was headed by late runners approaching the wire. LUNA BLU raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn then lacked a strong closing response. TEE GAME, well back early, was hustled four-wide late turn then lacked a rally.
