Footnotes

STAGE FRIGHT settled off the pace, closed up and stalked the leaders on the far turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch, launched a furious drive, challenged a 16th out and drove clear. CRUSHIN HARD traded the early lead back and forth with SILO RIDGE, forced the pace on the backstretch, bid midturn, dueled, wore down that rival midstretch but was caught and headed with a 16th to run. BARE IS BEST raced in midpack, stalked along the rail on the far turn, launched his bid upper stretch but failed to draw even. WIDMO settled off the pace, was unhurried to late turn then tendered a mild belated rally outside. SILO RIDGE set a pressured pace on the backstretch, was joined midturn, dueled gamely but tired midstretch. PLACING NO BLAME settled off the pace, angled out late turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the late stages. BEST BEWARE, steadied at the start, stalked the pace in hand, chased into the stretch then tired a furlong out.
