ARE YOU SERIOUS stalked from the rail, was roused at the top of the stretch, gained steadily and got up late. MAIN EXECUTIVE raced forwardly from the outset, sprinted clear midbackstretch, set the pace then failed to hold. COOL THE HEAT stalked three-wide, chased late turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch then flattened out. QUIET CANADIAN raced forwardly in the early stages, settled and stalked the pace on the backstretch, chased late turn then flattened out. DERBY HONORS raced on the second path, faded on the turn and showed no late response. INDIAN BAY saved ground, was roused on the turn but had no response.
