Footnotes

BOSSMAN BLUE'S raced forwardly, led into the turn, set the pace, was hustled into the stretch and held under a drive. BLUSHING BRAT stalked the pace in hand, was three and four-wide on the turn, launched a determined stretch drive and was gaining late. GRAPES, in range, dropped back on the turn, chased three-wide into the stretch, had traffic in front and angled in to the rail but quickly angled out then rallied gamely, but late. WINN CREEK, prominent early, stalked from the rail on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. SUPERBULL, prominent early, pressed the pace on the turn, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. CAPTAIN CHRIS stalked the pace, chased late turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch and evened out. ITS CHECKMATE, rated still in range at the rear of the pack, was hustled from midturn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch and lost ground then tired in the stretch.
