FOR TWO-YEAR-OLD FILLIES, Sired by a Stallion standing in Ontario for his entire season the year of conception and registered with the Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society for that season. By subscription of \$125 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,250 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. Weight 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a race other than claiming, 5 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500, which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 20 Nominations) *Plus up to \$10,200 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. \$95,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program.

CRYPTIC MESSAGE ducked in a bit at the start but recovered quickly and sprinted clear, set a reserved pace, was put to work a 16th out and held under a drive. PROFESSOR'S RIDE, in range, stalked the pace two-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. SILENT STAR raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide on the turn and finished all out. SEEKING TOUSSAUD, away alertly, settled in midpack, came four-wide through the turn then finished evenly. SUNSHINE JENNY, well back early, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. RING OF LUCK, in touch, chased along the rail on the turn then lacked a closing response.
