LUKES ALLEY settled in midpack, closed five-wide late turn, went by the leader midstretch and finished under a hand ride. BEST BARD, in midpack early, closed five-wide late turn, led briefly upper stretch but was no match for the winner. THANKS A MILLION stalked into the turn, saved ground then was all out through the stretch. SMOOTH STONE bobbled at the start, forced the issue, dueled on the turn, took a short led at the top of the stretch but was quickly passed. GOLDEN RIVET stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. I'M NO FAIRYTAIL, in touch, stalked three and four-wide on the turn then lacked a serious response in the stretch. EUREKA SPRINGS showed early speed, was joined early turn, dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired. SAVE MY SOUL settled off the pace, was hustled five-wide late turn then was all out in the stretch then was evened out. MAJOR IRONSIDES settled off the pace, saved ground, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. SUNSET COMMAND, away alertly, settled off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
