JOVIAL BLAST pressed the early pace outside of rivals, drew even at the quarter pole and dueled on the outside through the stretch prevailing in an all out drive. FRIENDLY PIONEER set a pressured pace between horses, dueled inside through the drive and weakened slightly in the final strides. EBONY COUNTESS was unhurried early between horses, roused four wide on the turn and closed willingly in the drive. NO CHEATING was hustled along inside of rivals, angled out on the turn and made a mild bid, but was blocked in upper stretch, moved back to the rail for the final furlong and finished well. FRESH BELIEVER was close up four wide and ran evenly. PENDA dwelt slightly and spotted the field six lengths, moved to the outside on the turn and rallied four wide on the turn, but flattened out in the drive and was pulled up in the final strides. MINERS MIRACLE was hustled along close up inside of rivals, then tired. TRICKY MOMENT was void of early speed along the rail and never a factor. COME HOME CATHY was hustled along between horses, then dropped back on the turn.
