KNIGHT'S CAUSE stalked three-wide, bid inside the leader upper stretch, drove clear then widened under steady handling. FULL OF WISDOM, well back early, raced three-wide on the turn, angled out leaving the turn and rallied gamely. SPRY CAT pressed the pace, bid into the turn, dueled then edged ahead late turn, was headed upper stretch then finished all out. I'M A LITTLE FISH stalked along the rail, closed into the stretch and finished all out to no avail. GIVE US THIS DAY raced off the pace, came three then four-wide through the turn, was six-wide at the top of the stretch, chased, but evened out late. SHANGHAI KNIGHT, in range early, dropped back late backstretch, saved ground on the turn, appeared poised to rally but lacked a clear path in the late stages. VINTAGE MALT stalked from between horses, was hustled late turn, launched his stretch drive and was all out between rivals but evened out late. QUINZEE, well back, closed five-wide late turn, came seven-wide into the stretch then evened out in the final furlong. FAGAN, off a step slowly, gained contention late backstretch, raced two-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. RATHCOOLE showed speed, was headed early, pressed the pace three-wide, chased to midstretch and tired. SENOR AL, in range four-wide, was steadied in traffic upper stretch and flattened out. FLASH OF TIME, well back early, closed four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. TUONO had early speed, dueled into the turn, gave way late turn and faded.
