POINTLESS LOVE, in range, closed five-wide late turn, bid upper stretch, drew clear quickly and widened under a hand ride. ZIPCO, rated off the pace, was hustled on the turn, angled out approaching the stretch then rallied six-wide. SEEKING THE CODE stalked the pace, chased late turn angling six-wide then finished all out. DANAHER broke inward, raced well back, was hustled three to six-wide through the turn and rallied belatedly outside the field. SILVER ROCKET, off alertly, settled, chased from midpack on the turn angling seven-wide then evened out in the late stages. ARGUMENT CLOSE settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. DUCK TRAIL and SHACKLETON HILL dueled from early backstretch, were passed upper stretch and tired.
