SKIPPING LASS dueled early along the inside, shook loose in upper stretch and edged away under a vigorous hand ride. SHOELESS SUE battled outside the winner to the top of the stretch and held well for the place. NEGANO waited briefly behind horses on the far turn, angled in while rallying on the turn then finished evenly. CAPIANA failed to seriously threaten while three wide. CRYPTO FACTO never reached contention. GINGER GERRY raced up close between horses and faded on the turn. BYZANTINE saved ground while just off the pace for a half and gave way on the turn. SHEER JOY was never a factor.
