Plus up to \$11,040 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Nominations closed Wednesday, July 19, 2006 with 26.

HIDE AND CHIC raced off the pace along the rail, responded in the stretch, rallied willingly and got up late, driving. FINANCINGAVAILABLE stalked the

pace, bid at the 3/16th pole and drove clear but failed to contain winner in the late stages. SOCIETY HOSTESS stalked from between horses, launched an all out stretch drive and was gaining late. COUNT TO THREE, in touch between foes, was hustled late turn, finished determinedly and was coming determinedly in deep stretch. PRETTY JANE trailed along the rail, angled out upper stretch then moved back to the rail a furlong out and was gaining late. MOCHA QUEEN raced midpack between horses, angled out upper stretch and rallied. VELVET SNOW, well back along the second path, lacked a strong late response. BECKY SHARP was prominent early, shook clear into the turn, set the pace well into the stretch, engaged by FINANCINGAVAILABLE, could not stay and tired. BRIGHT GOLD stalked three-wide, was up close under a ride until midstretch and tired. PANDORA'S SECRET raced midpack, was hustled three-wide on the turn and tired in the stretch. BLACK ROCK ROAD rated early, raced on the fourth path and lacked a closing response.
