DADDYS JEWEL raced off the pace, was hustled from late backstretch, came three and four-wide through the turn, bid a furlong out and held sway while lugging in. ACTING NAUGHTY stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn, led briefly upper stretch, was headed and finished gamely. AWFULLY SINFUL, off a step slowly, stalked the pace, was hustled from the rail on the turn and finished determinedly. WIND SPEAKER raced off the pace, was hustled late backstretch, angled two to four-wide on the turn then finished gamely in vain. NO IT ISN'T raced in midpack, angled two-wide to five-wide through the turn but lacked a rally. LOVELY LO dueled, edged clear late backstretch, set the pace then tired upper stretch. A LISTER stalked early then settled off the pace, was hustled from the rail to three-wide on the turn but lacked a rally. MISS SILVER BULETT bobbled slightly at the start, dueled briefly, chased on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
