EXECUTIVE SHERRI stalked the pace, closed along the rail late turn, took command at the top of the stretch, widened when asked and finished under a hand ride. FLATT OUT LUCKY raced in the middle of the pack, was roused five-wide late turn then rallied gamely to no avail. TEA BAY raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide into the stretch then finished gamely between foes. BEAUJELAIS NOUVEAU, in touch, angled three to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. MAYBE I CAN raced off the pace, closed five-wide late turn but never reached contention. SASSY N' FLASHY sprinted clear quickly, set a reserved pace, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased briefly and tired. COGNAC MISS forced the pace to the turn, was hustled still in striking range to the stretch and tired. HONOUR FULFILLED raced midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn then tired in the final furlong. BRITANNIA was always well back, raced along the rail and out to the third path through the turn then lacked a rally.
