STOCKWATCHER, away slowly, settled off the pace along the rail, chased into the stretch, bid a furlong out, drove clear and held sway under steady handling. WHY TIE THE KNOT away slowly, settled off the pace, was hustled three to six-wide through the turn then finished under a determined drive. SINE METU, also away slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then rallied mildly outside. NORMAL NORM stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn but evened out in deep stretch. DOUGHMAKER, off slowly, stalked three-wide, chased on the turn but flattened out in the stretch. STAND EM UP led quickly, set a pressured pace, was caught a furlong out and gave way. PRIOMH AIRE settled off the pace, was roused three-wide late turn but had no response in the stretch. GOODNEWSWITHATWIST forced the issue to the top of the stretch and tired.
