Footnotes

DANCING BAY, hustled from midpack, closed four and five-wide on the turn, challenged at the top of the stretch, drove clear then finished under a hand ride. ROTHAM TRIPLE E'S raced forwardly, forced the pace on the turn, bid upper stretch but was outkicked and chased to the wire. SYNERGIST raced in midpack, chased hard on the turn, was all out in the stretch and was closing late. STRUT THE COURSE settled off the pace, chased four-wide late turn then finished willingly in vain. FIREWITHDESIRE was hustled from midpack, angled three-wide to five-wide through the turn, showed a good late move but was not a threat. LUCK BE THE LADY, prominent early, held a short lead on the turn, was headed upper stretch then evened out. WE'LL TALK, off slowly, raced well back, saved ground but was never in contention. VICAR OF DIBLEY stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in deep stretch. SHIMMER OF GOLD, in range, chased hard late turn then evened out in the stretch. PRIMORDIA settled off the pace, came four-wide to six-wide through the turn and never threatened. TAKARA COVE, off slowly, was hustled from midpack on the turn but tired in the stretch. BANK ON IT, in touch, chased two-wide on the turn but tired in the stretch.
