BEAR'S PEAK, close early in hand, bid along the rail late turn, had command at the top of the stretch and moved clear then held sway under a drive. COURTVILLE stalked the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn, lost ground chasing into the stretch then finished under an all out rally. HAVERHILL raced in midpack, chased late turn then tendered a mild late rally. URBAN FORESTER showed speed, pressed the pace into the turn, chased four-wide then evened out in deep stretch. SNIPER showed early speed then forced the pace, was hustled into the stretch then evened out with a 16th to run. MR. MONTY showed speed, gained a short lead late backstretch, moved clear early turn but was collared at the 1/4 pole, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. MARKED IN STONE, rated in midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn but never reached contention. ONE MORE DEAL settled off the pace, was hustled five and six-wide on the turn, chased seven-wide into the stretch but lacked a late response.
