Footnotes

HANDPAINTED stalked the early pace in the three path, drew even three wide on the turn, then drew clear in the stretch under intermittent urging. BUFFALO JUMP was allowed to settle inside of rivals, angled off the rail on the turn, but was blocked entering the stretch, followed the winner and moved into the hole that one created and got up for place. CURIOSITY was slow early along the rail, saved ground on the turn, then swung wide in the drive and closed fast in the late going. TO THE CHAPEL was away alertly and set the pace off the rail, gave way between horses on the turn and faltered entering the stretch. BETTER HALF stalked the early pace inside of rivals, then weakened in the late going. LIL SCOUT was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused four wide on the turn and closed the gap in upper stretch, but flattened out in the drive. BRUSQUE stumbled at the start and lost the jockey.
