Footnotes

HOLD THAT ECHO raced off the pace, closed between foes late turn, rallied gamely and got up late, driving. TIGRA MARA stalked the pace, closed into the stretch, gained steadily, bid a 16th out, led for a few strides then failed to contain the winner. STARS IN MY EYES, rated in range, bid midturn, had command at the top of the stretch, moved clear then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. WISEHER raced off the pace, closed into the stretch, angled out sharply then rallied willingly. NASIRIYAH'S SONG raced off the pace, angled from three-wide to seven-wide on the turn then finished all out. THREE INTHE

KITTY raced midpack, angled from three to five-wide through the turn, bumped with a rival at the top of the stretch then evened out late stages. LASTFUL APPEAL settled well back, closed angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn, rallied, but evened out late. HINT OF LEMON raced midpack, angled from two to five-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. ALTA LAKE raced off the pace, closed into the turn and stalked, bumped with a rival at the top of the stretch then flattened out. HARLEM PRINCESS raced off the pace, closed four-wide on the turn, chased up close to the top of the stretch and tired. SPANISH POST stalked in hand, bid late turn, vied briefly and yielded at the top of the stretch and was through. SILLY STREET raced in midpack then faded along the rail through the turn. DUBAI CALLING raced midpack, was still in range late turn but had no stretch response and tired. GODDESS OF DOOM showed early speed, set the pace, was headed midturn and faded along the rail.
