ELUSIVE TARA stalked the pace, angled from two to five-wide through the turn, rallied gamely and got up late, driving. IMPROVISING set a pressured pace, was clear late turn then failed to hold the winner safe in deep stretch. WANADAY broke outward, closed on the backstretch, came three and four-wide through the turn, angled out midstretch and rallied gamely. SOUL OF FASHION stalked the pace, angled four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. SWEET MAY WEST bobbled at the start, raced off the pace, was under a patient ride through the turn then lacked a serious rally. SHARP ENOUGH pressed the pace along the rail, stalked on the turn then lacked a closing response. RACINDA forced the pace, chased three-wide into the stretch, was forced to steady a furlong out then flattened out. KITTY AVENUE raced off the pace, settled well back, trailed the field through the turn then lacked a rally.
